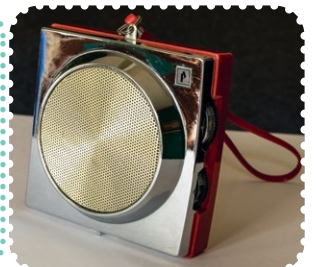

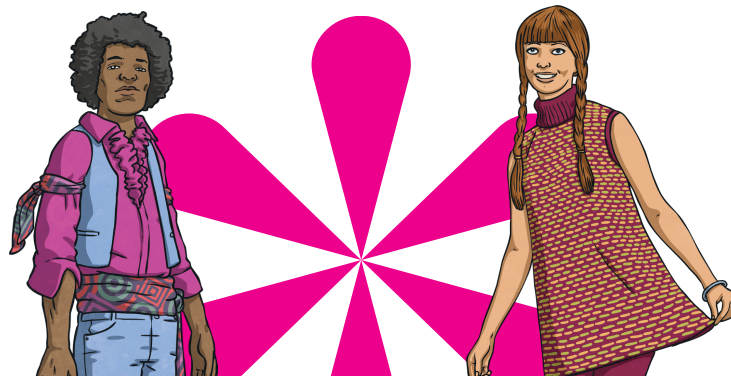

Who created the character of James Bond?

The British writer Ian Fleming created James Bond in his 1953 novel *Casino Royale*. He wrote a series of books about the secret agent between 1953 and 1966. The books have sold more than 18 million copies in many different languages.

What is James Bond's code number?

His code number is 007. The prefix 00 means that James Bond is 'licensed to kill' – he can kill people if he needs to. Bond gets this code name at the start of the first novel, *Casino Royale*, when he killed his enemies. He has killed more than 150 villains since!

How does he defeat his enemies?

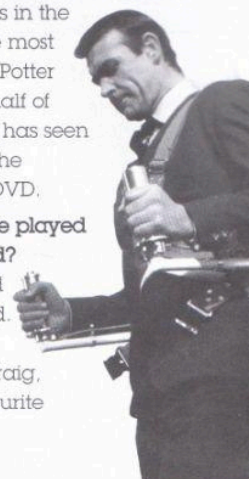
He uses his intelligence, strength, and high-tech weapons and devices. In the early stories these were guns or explosives that looked like everyday objects (a watch or a pen for example). In later stories the devices became more sophisticated and included X-ray glasses and a jetpack.

How many James Bond films have there been?

There have been 22 official James Bond films. The first film was *Dr. No* in 1962, starring Sean Connery. The Bond films are the second most successful series of films in the history of cinema. (The most successful is the Harry Potter series.) In fact, about half of the world's population has seen a James Bond film at the cinema, on TV, or on DVD.

How many actors have played the part of James Bond?

Six actors have played the part of James Bond. The current Bond is English actor Daniel Craig, but most people's favourite Bond is the original – Sean Connery.

Could James Bond Be Female One Day?

Who is James Bond? · James Bond is a fictional spy who

was created by Ian Fleming in 1953.

· The spy has featured in 39 books and 24 films. In every film, a male actor has played the lead role.

Recent discussions have taken place over the fictional character James Bond and whether the role could ever be played by a female actor.

The fictional Secret Service spy was created as a book character by author Ian Fleming in 1953. Since then, 39 officially licensed books and 24 films have made the Super-Smooth spy a favourite with many readers and filmgoers.

James Bond was written as a male character and has always been played by male actors. However, some have recently questioned whether it is time to see an **alternative** Bond - one played by a female - to reflect the modern world and help promote women in strong roles.

The executive producer of the Bond films, Barbara Broccoli (a successful, well-respected woman in the film industry), has said that there will never be a female Bond! She believes that Bond was created as a male character and he should stay as a male. Instead, she suggested that other strong female characters should be developed and the stories made to fit around them.

Conversely, Prime Minister Theresa May supports the idea as she told reporters recently that "one day there should be a female James Bond."

The discussion has been **prompted** by the fact that the title role in the popular British television series 'Dr Who' is currently being

played by a female - Jodie Whittaker. She has so far received very good reviews for her performance as the time-travelling doctor.

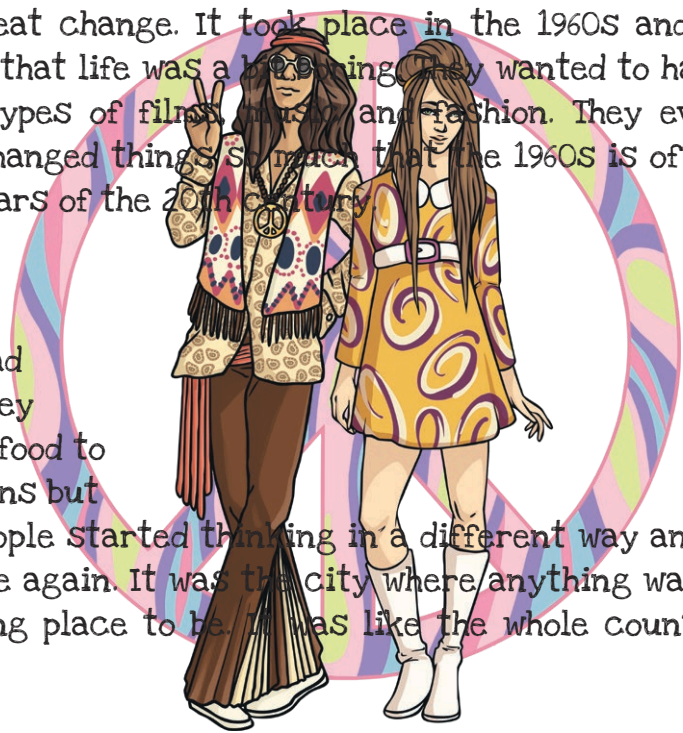

The Swinging 60s

The Swinging 60s was a time of great change. It took place in the 1960s and it happened because young people felt that life was a bit boring. They wanted to have more fun and started liking new types of films, music and fashion. They even looked at the world differently. It changed things so much that the 1960s is often known as the most important ten years of the 20th century.

After the Second World War, life in Britain had been hard. A lot of people were poor and many places had been destroyed. There was little money and sometimes there wasn't enough food to go around. A lot of London was in ruins but something changed in the 1960s. People started thinking in a different way and London was soon an important place again. It was the city where anything was possible and it was a really exciting place to be. It was like the whole country had been born again.



Music



People from around the world started listening to British music. Some British bands became the most famous of all. They had fans everywhere. People from as far away as America, Australia and Europe loved their songs. A lot of the music in the 1960s was bright and happy but some groups sang about standing up for what you believe.

A lot of the music was also about peace. Even though the Second World War was over, there were still other wars being fought around the world. Many bands sang about ending wars and fighting. They showed people how horrible wars could be and sang about love and peace. They asked the people who made decisions why wars were still taking place.

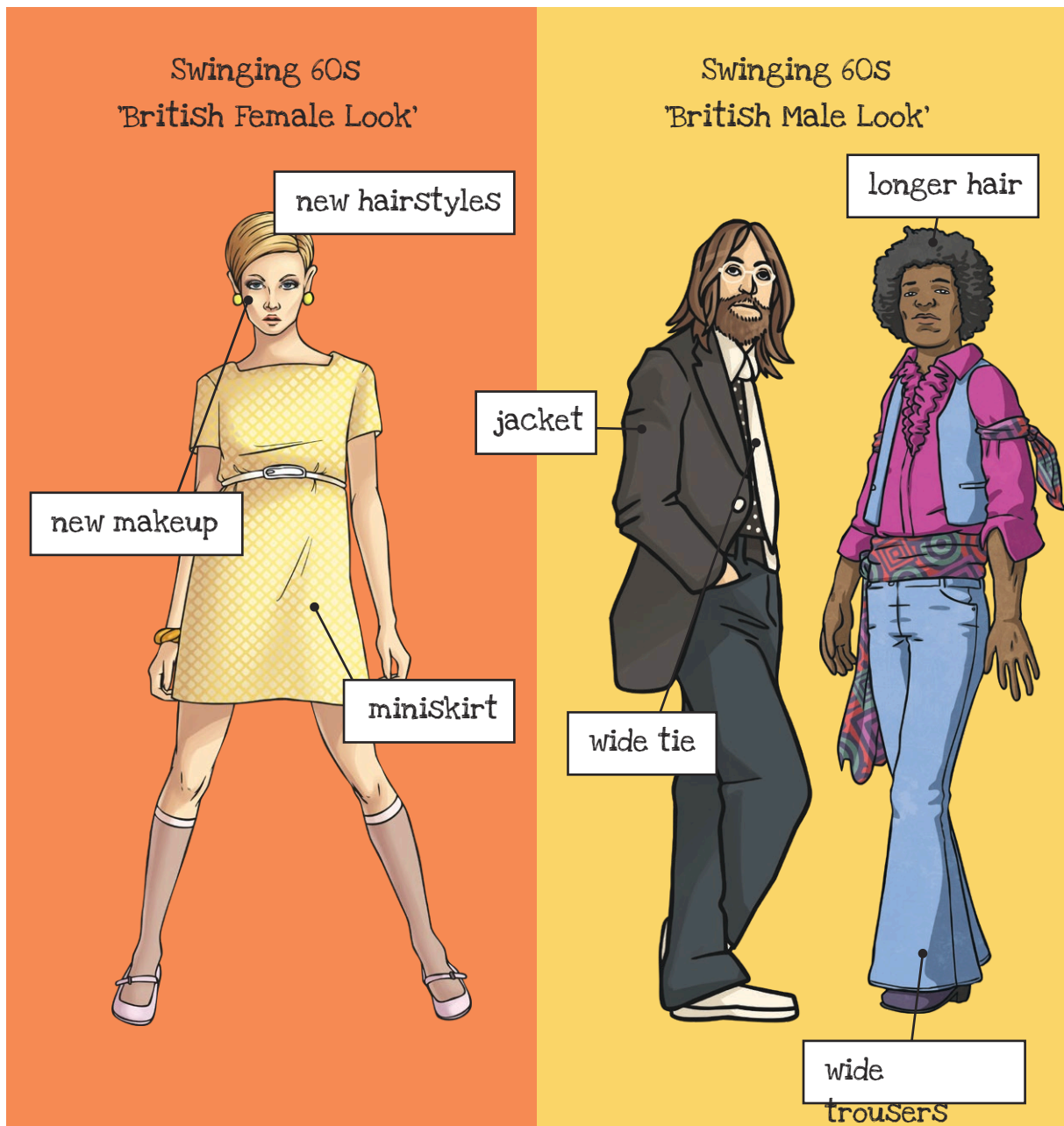
Even now, 1960s music is popular and some of the bands are still going today.



Fashion

Fashion during the Swinging 60s looked very different to that of the 1940s and 50s. Designers, models and fashion magazines had new styles, like the miniskirt, and people loved dressing differently. The most popular areas were in London. Shops in Carnaby Street and King's Road were the best places for people wanting the latest fashion.

Although a lot of the Swinging 60s was about women's fashion, men's fashion also changed. Everything seemed to get wider!

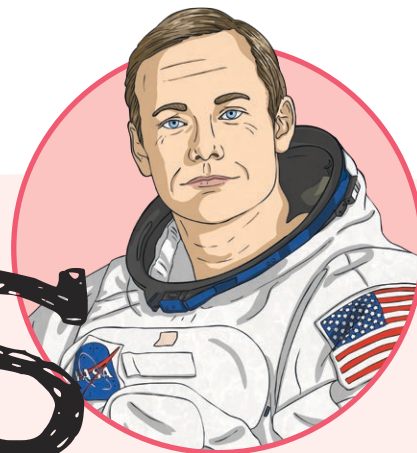
