- The Underground is the oldest transport system of its kind in the world.
- Some parts of the Underground were built in 1863.

- Big Ben is the name of a large bell. · It is inside a clock tower called the Elizabeth Tower.
- It is a famous landmark next to the river Thames.

- It opened in 1828.
