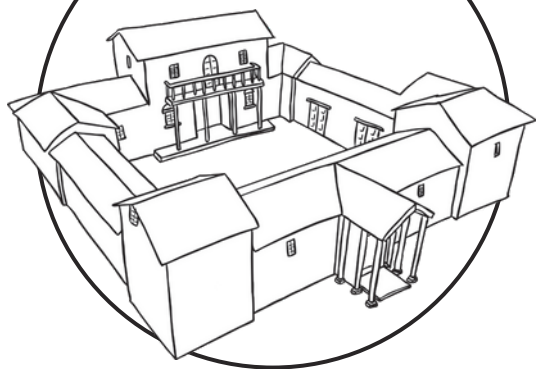
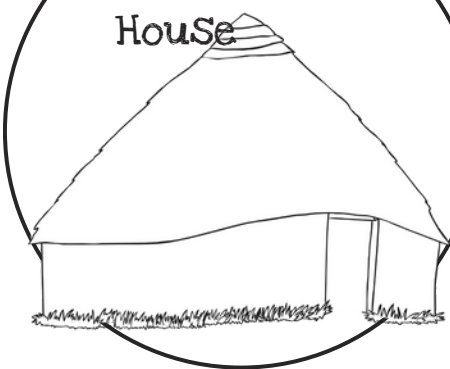

Roman and Celtic House Comparison Answers

Similarities	Difference
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Celtic houses had wooden poles around the building to support the roof. · Roman villas had columns to support upper levels (and for decoration). · Both Celtic houses and Roman villas had sloped roofs. 	<p>Celtic houses were round in shape. Roman villas were square or rectangular in shape.</p> <p>Celtic houses had animal skins covering the floors. Roman villas had mosaics and tiles.</p> <p>Roman villas were heated using a hypocaust (underfloor heating using hot air from a furnace under the ground floor).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Celtic houses had a fire in a clay pot on the floor · Celtic houses had a thatched roof (made of grass or straw). · Roman villas had tiled roofs. · Roman villas were made of many rooms. · Celtic houses were made of one large room. · Celtic houses were built using wattle and daub (woven wood plastered with straw and mud). Roman villas were made of stone. · Celtic houses did not have any windows. · Roman villas had many windows.
